FIRST THINGS FIRST: ROLL THE TOP


1 ROLL THE PANNIERS FOR WEATHERPROOF SEAL
Leave ample room to allow for at least three rolls to seal. Before rolling, push top down to squeeze air from bag.



Roll at least three times.




Buckle compression straps and cinch webbing tight.




QUICK MOUNTING YOUR MOTOTREKK PANNIERS

2 SECURE MOTOTREKK PANNIERS TO RACK
Position Panniers on horizontal bars of the luggage frame using the wheel side quick mount strap. Pull red label to unlatch magnetic fastener.




3 ADJUST QUICK CONNECT STRAP
Adjust the panniers to the desired position and tighten the strap by pulling down on the webbing.

The quick connect strap holds the Pannier in place while you mount it. Use cut-out slots and adjustment at top of strap to create a snug fit with the magnetic buckle positioned roughly in the center of the Pannier. Trim excess webbing and singe end with lighter or secure extra webbing with elastic strap keeper to prevent strap end from being damaged by wheel, exhaust or chain.




NOTE: If any part of the Pannier or strap touches exhaust, install a Giant Loop Hot Springs Heat Shield to prevent damage (optional accessory, not included with Panniers).

4 SECURE SIDE ANCHOR STRAPS
Wrapping the anchor webbing around the inside of the rack frame, secure by inserting aluminum hooks into the webbing loop as shown, keeping delrin lash loop positioned so it can be used to attach additional gear or an optional waterproof Possibles Pouch after mounting Panniers.



IMPORTANT! INSERT ALUMINUM HOOK INSIDE THE WEBBING LOOP, NOT AROUND IT.

DO NOT slide around webbing loop.




Insert **INSIDE** webbing loop.




Repeat the same on the other side and the bottom buckles until all four buckles are looped into the webbing.

5 CONNECT TOP STRAPS
Connect top compression straps over top of luggage rack to provide additional support for Pannier. Pull firmly to tighten.




6 CONNECT FRONT STRAPS
Buckle front compression straps. Tighten by pulling out firmly in opposite directions as shown. These straps draw tension on the anchors and secure the Panniers tightly to the frames. **ALWAYS KEEP THESE STRAPS FULLY TENSIONED AND THE PANNIERS COMPRESSED EVEN WHEN EMPTY.** Repeat procedure for opposite side of motorcycle.



IMPORTANT! TENSION ON THE FRONT STRAPS IS CRITICAL TO ENSURE THE BAG REMAINS SECURE ON THE FRAME.

Repeat for bottom buckles.




DOUBLE CHECK STRAPS

Double check all compression straps to ensure a snug fit.

ALWAYS KEEP COMPRESSION STRAPS FULLY TENSIONED AND THE PANNIERS COMPRESSED EVEN WHEN EMPTY TO PREVENT ANCHOR HOOKS FROM COMING LOOSE.


If Panniers are going to be in close contact with exhaust components, Giant Loop highly recommends installing the Hot Springs Heat Shields (sold separately).



TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THE D-RINGS


OPTIONAL REINFORCEMENT
Additional reinforcement can be applied by connecting the shoulder straps through the D-rings and applying tension.

ATTACH POSSIBLES POUCH
The Giant Loop Possibles Pouch can be easily and securely attached on either the front or back of the MotoTrek Panniers using the D-Rings as shown.



TAKE YOUR PANNIERS WITH YOU

MotoTrek Panniers include shoulder straps that can be clipped into the D-rings (as shown) that serve as shoulder straps so the Panniers can be conveniently carried around as a backpack.



MOTOTREKK™ PANNIERS PACKING TIPS



- The MotoTrek Panniers are waterproof when tops are rolled at least three times.
- Use Giant Loop's Saddlebag Dry Pods (optional, not included) or other stuff sacks to keep gear organized and easily accessible inside Panniers.
- Do not overstuff or over-load Panniers. The challenge should be to pack as little as necessary to be safe, comfortable and self-sufficient. Go light. Go fast. Go far.
- Take care to pack the heaviest gear as low as possible, preferably below the seat line, with weight balanced from side-to-side. Your bike will handle far better with weight positioned as close to the center of the bike as possible.
- When off the bike, clip the included shoulder straps to D-rings on the bottom and back of the Panniers to carry them like a backpack.
- To avoid wearing through the MotoTrek Panniers from vibrations, pack all sharp and/or hard items inside a protective layer. For example, create a sleeve for tire irons from a section of old inner tuber, pack tools in rolls and wrap other hard items in clothing.
- Expand Panniers by anchoring Giant Loop's waterproof roll-top Possibles Pouches (optional, not included) to the lash loops on the front and back of the Panniers.
- A tight, compressed fit is critically important. After riding a short distance, stop and re-tighten all anchor and compression straps, as gear shifts and compresses while riding. Even when bag is empty it should be fully compressed to provide a secure fit.

Possibles Pouch

Straps to front or back of Panniers, creating 3.5-liter waterproof, quickly accessible external pockets.



Tillamook Dry Bag

Waterproof double-ended duffel anchors between Panniers.



Saddlebag Dry Pods

Add waterproof organization inside Panniers.



Hot Springs Heat Shield

Add protection to prevent Panniers from touching exhaust.
